

## **SCHEDULE**

### **Diving Rules and Regulation**

The constitution of North Wales Technical Divers Club (NWTDC) annexed hereto contains Rules and Regulations that all divers must adhere to.

The Liability Release agreement annexed hereto forms part of the Diving Rules and Regulations.

Every member must hold a technical diver qualification that certifies them to conduct planned decompression dives using mixed gases as a bottom gas and/or decompression gas.

Each diving member will be a current BSAC member.

The Licensee will only issue a permission to dive when all the necessary checks have been made to confirm that the prospective member holds the minimum qualifications detailed above. A record will be kept of diving qualifications.

The NWTDC will only issue a membership card permitting diving when all necessary checks have been made to confirm that the prospective member conforms to the requirements detailed in the constitution.

The permission to dive will only be issued when the person diving has signed a declaration that there is no liability on the Licensor and that the diver acknowledges and complies with the Diving Rules and Regulations.

Access to the site is restricted to Saturday and Sundays only (subject to demand). Access at any other time will be by special arrangement with NWTDC Club and remains subject to these Rules and Regulations.

Members wishing to dive must carry their NWTDC Club membership card to gain access to the site.

Members wishing to dive must arrive at the main gate between 10.00 am 10.30 where they will be met by the Licensee who will maintain a written log detailing the members name and membership number. The gates will be locked at 10.30 am and there will no admittance thereafter.

The gates will be open from 15.00 to 15.30 for members to leave the site. The Licensee will ensure that all members who were logged in are logged out. The gates will be locked at 15.30.

There is an established protocol for access with the Emergency Services.

All NWTDC Club members using the site who witness unauthorised diving, illegal or anti-social behaviour must report such incidents to the Licensee at the earliest opportunity.
